ABSTRACT	<p>Smart Mature Resilience (SMR) is an EU project developing guidelines on resilience assessment and implementation to increase Europe's resilience to shocks and stresses. SMR will develop and validate the guidelines using three pilot projects covering security sectors, climate changes and social dynamics. The guideline is a tool that cities can use to resist, absorb, overcome and adapt to the consequences of various disasters in a timely and efficient manner. One of the ways this will happen is through the preservation and rapid recovery of important structures and functions.</p>
